Some Brief information on myself, I have been with FYBA for 8 years and a member of the board for 5 years, Along with being V.P. of Coach Pitch, I am also V.P. of Umpires, and this year am also coaching my grandkids Tee Ball team I have been involved in youth baseball for over 35 years. Some important dates are as follows.

Managers meeting March 9thth at Cincinnati Christian School from 6:30, you or someone for you must be there  
Equipment pick up at water works March 26th from 10-12  
Practices start March 12th- you or some one for you must pick up equipment  
Uniform pickup TBA  
Season starts-Opening day- April 16th  
Picture Day May 15th  
Season ends June 30th  
West side all star tournament July 4th weekend  
FYBA all star tournament July 9-11  
Equipment turn in- TBA

Please use Thursday and Friday to call all your players. Do this as soon as possible or they will be calling me. Pick your equipment up on Saturday, if you can not do it have a coach, wife, friend, or other manager pick it up for you, this is the only pick up date.

Fields we use for games are Water Works Fields #6 and #7, we also use Oak Wood Park fields #1 and #2 for practices. You will be given a practice schedule that gives every body equal time on the fields. If you want to practice else where you must let me know first. Carry the Fairfield Parks letter that gives FYBA use of this park if some one else is on the field show them the letter and ask them to please move. If this does not work call the police. Practice times during the year are a first come basis, requested to me by email at least 3 days in advance.

We will schedule every body 20 games, with no make up games rescheduled as long as you play 14 games. Schedules will be out by eary April

We use a coachs call line to call all parents to update them on rainouts because

of bad weather, we also have a rain out line you may call at 829-7292, As soon as this is set up you will be given information that will let you call one number and leave a message and it will go out to all your parents at once.
